Also there will be music workshops, movement and improv activities, creative writing activities, Elder circles and community engagement sessions as part of this project. There will be activities outdoors in the fall and spring, such as celebrations of the Neighbourhood Arts Ottawa projects, sketching in the nearby parks, singing outside, etc.

■ COVID-19

The following are precautions and protocols that are in place for the safety of everyone involved in the program/activity or series of programs/activities due to the Covid 19 Pandemic:

At present, **Participants must wear masks** at all times for face to face events including; registration, workshops, performances, art exhibitions that take place indoors. Participants will change into provided masks at entrance and dispose of these when leaving the activity. There will be no exception to this requirement but we can provide socially distanced activities for those not able to wear masks. Masks must cover both nose and mouth at all times. If snacks are served, we will eat them outside if at all possible. Face to face events will have 2 meter distancing if masks are taken off such as for singing.

Physical distancing will mean that participants sit in social bubble / family groups distanced 2 meters from others who they don't have social contact with elsewhere. Group sizes will be limited as per guidelines for the venues we use.

Regular handwashing and/or use of sanitizer or disposable gloves will be required. **Also all participants will assist with disinfection of the tables and chairs they sat at.** This will also be done between each session by staff or volunteers. Please note that outdoor activities will not have access to washrooms so plan for this!

Pre Screening will be done at each event. You are asked not to come to any event if you have symptoms that might be attributed to Covid 19 or have been in contact with anyone with symptoms or a positive covid 19 test result in the last two weeks. Please know that you will be asked specific questions and sign a log in sheet (or for your children) at entry. This will require patience as all participants will need to line up with proper physical distancing and respect for the time this will take. We will have red markings on the pavement in the community garden area where we meet to assist with this.

Guidelines may change at any time. Precautions and protocols are determined in accordance with the public health guidelines for the Province of Ontario <https://www.publichealthontario.ca/> and the City of Ottawa. As these guidelines change, so will program precautions and protocols. Any changes will be communicated to participants as soon as they occur.
